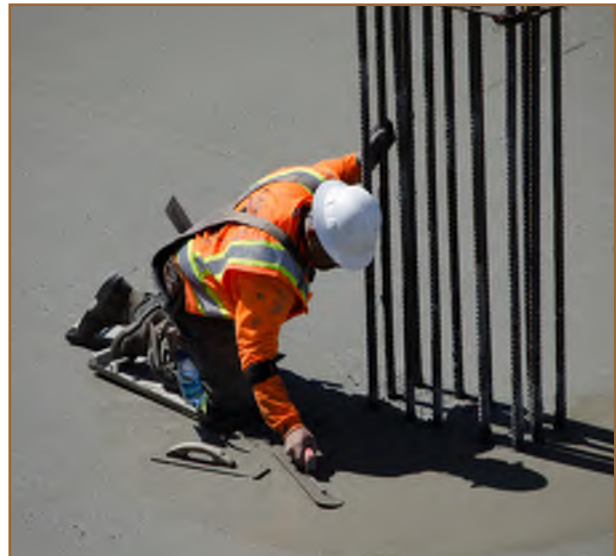

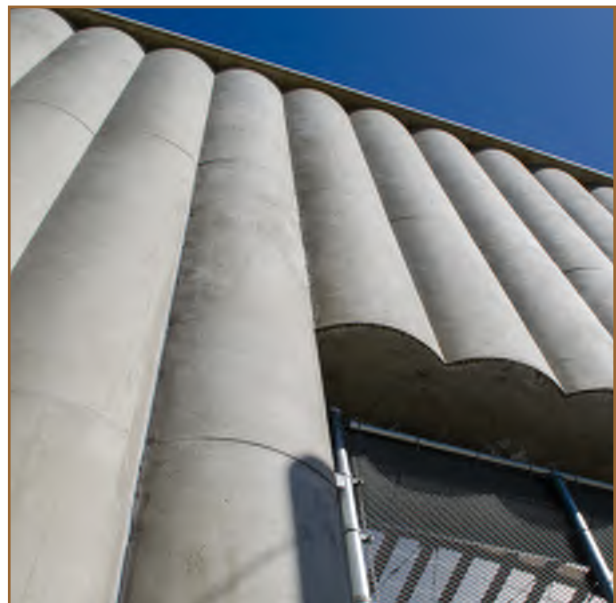

AUTOCAD & BUILDING INFORMATION MODELING

Largo Concrete is committed to utilizing the latest technologies in AutoCAD and Building Information Modeling (BIM) software to continually enhance our process. We have been using AutoCAD for decades to gain a better understanding of a project leading up to the bid and generating in-house shop drawings and as-builts during construction. We have invested in Autodesk Revit BIM software, which included formal training for our personnel to utilize these powerful tools to their full potential.



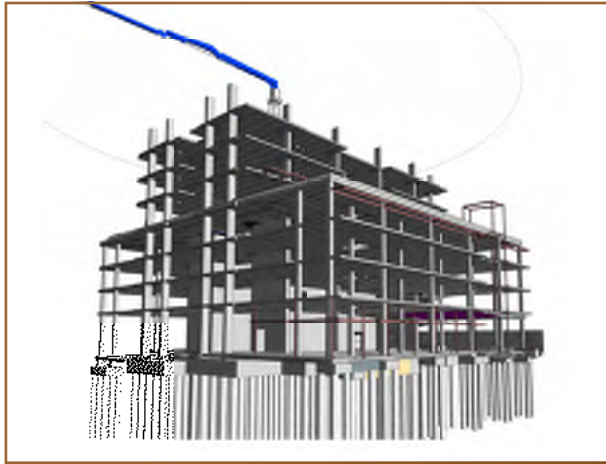
Under the supervision of our in-house Professional Engineer, Moti Salas, our detailing department utilizes these tools to conduct dimensional analysis and visualize elements overlooked by the design team. Conducting this enhanced review during the early stages of the project minimizes conflicts in the field and change orders during construction. BIM software enhances this process by allowing our teams to conduct these reviews in the third dimension and providing a single, consistent source of all information on the project rather than a basic geometrical description of individual objects. This process allows our team and all stakeholders to play a more active role in the design and construction of the project.

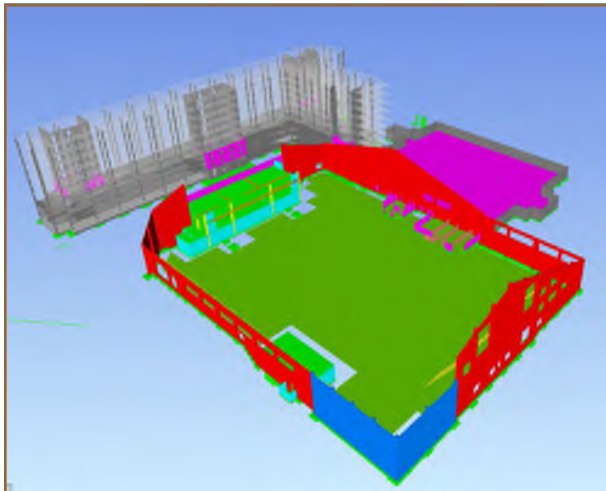
AUTOCAD & BUILDING INFORMATION MODELING

After award, we work with the general contractor and trade contractors to integrate all other building systems with the structural concrete model for clash detection. This collaborative process adds another level of checks and balances before construction begins. Participation in weekly meetings throughout construction keep the model up to date until the as-built model is turned over to the client.

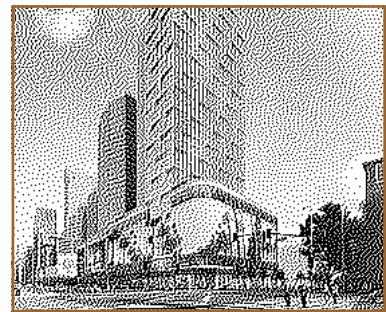

Plant Information: Located in Riverside County the Genesis Solar Project will generate nearly 250MW of renewable energy annually utilizing Concentrating Solar Energy technology to heat a synthetic oil or Heat Transfer Fluid (HTF). The HTF is then used to heat water and create steam which turns turbines and generates electricity for 88,000 homes annually. This is the equivalent of removing 330,000 tons of carbon dioxide if the energy was produced from fossil fuels. The inside of the parabolic troughs are lined with reflective material focusing the sun's energy to heat HTF running through insulated tubes running along the focal point of the troughs.
